Items you will need to fill out the application:

$\hfill\square$ Employer identification Number (EIN) or Social Security Number (used for filing your business taxes).
\square Oregon Secretary of State Business Identification Number (BIN). You must have a current registration with the Oregon Secretary of State, including if you are a Sole Proprietor.

☐ NAICS Code. Your NAICS code identifies your business industry. You can find your NAICS code on your tax documents or look it up here: https://www.census.gov/naics/
$\hfill\square$ Total number of FTE Employees. Part-time employees are counted as .5 FTE each.
☐ Copy of your CURRENT government issued ID (front and back). [REQUIRED FOR ALL BUSINESSES]
 □ Copy of your 2019 Tax documents. [REQUIRED FOR ALL BUSINESSES] • LLC's and Sole Proprietors, attach Form 1040: Schedule C • Registered Corporations, attach Form 1120 • Registered Partnerships, attach Form 1065
\square A description of how COVID-19 negatively impacted your business.
